



As a Greenwich employee do you think Royal Greenwich is an Inner London or Outer London borough?

You may be surprised to know that Royal Greenwich is an outer London borough and council staff, and school support staff receive Outer London weighting allowance. Yet teachers who work in Royal Greenwich schools receive Inner London weighting allowance.

What is the Campaign about?

Greenwich Council employees have historically received Outer London weighting allowance, while teachers are paid the higher Inner London weighting rate. GMB believe this is an unfair allocation of the payments as, no matter where you work in London, the cost of living is the same.

GMB started the campaign in February 2024 with a mass protest on the steps of Greenwich Town Hall, at the full council meeting. This gave our members the opportunity to speak with the Councilors and let them know they are unhappy, and that this unfairness will no longer be tolerated by their employees.

GMB have listened to what our members want and have launched this campaign to get the council to pay *all* council staff employees the Inner London weighting allowance. **No ifs, No buts!**

Stuart Fegan, GMB Senior Organiser said:

“The mass protest was purely about fairness. Council staff and school support staff in Greenwich are paid the lower Outer London weighting payments yet they work in the same borough as Teachers, who receive the higher Inner London payment. If Greenwich schools are Inner London for teachers, then it *must* be Inner London for all Greenwich employees!”
