#### Motion - Agenda Item 3b - Adoption of Aims and Objectives

"The GMB Judges Branch adopts the Consultative Council of European Judges (CCJE) Opinion 23 on the role of a judge's association, which establishes relevant international standards. CCJE advises the Council of Europe.

Accordingly GMB J25 Judges Branch's Aims & Objectives are:

- 1 contributing to the administering of justice in conjunction with those responsible for it
- 2 promoting fair recruitment, promotion and disciplinary practices
- 3 defending judges and judiciary against any infringements of independence,
- 4 claiming sufficient resources and satisfactory working conditions
- 5 aiming for adequate remuneration and social security
- 6 rejecting unfair criticism and attacks against the judiciary and individual judges
- 7 establishing, promoting and implementing ethical standards, and
- 8 safeguarding non-discrimination and gender balance.

The term 'judges' has been used above for brevity. 'Judges' are all Judicial Office Holders including tribunal expert members such as doctors."
