Retiring from work? Stay with GMB - your union



Every GMB region has a Retired Members Association. Here's the information you need to join Southern Region GMB's RMA.

About the RMAs

The RMAs are enshrined in the GMB rule book – their purpose is to both support the national union and to campaign for the interests of retired members.

We have a regional RMA committee and send two members to the GMB's national RMA committee. We hold at least one conference of members in the region each year and send delegates to the national RMA conference.

We are supported by a regional officer appointed by the Regional Secretary.

How to join

All retired members with five years membership or more are invited to apply to become a "Retired Life Member". When accepted you will pay no further subscriptions to the union but may still be entitled to Legal Assistance under Rule 26 and Funeral Benefit under Rule 53. You can check this out <u>here</u>.

What we do

What we do depends on you. Your voice is heard at the regional RMA members' meetings, and if elected, on the regional RMA committee – so make sure you attend and/or keep in touch with officers.
