

Brighton Pavilion RPMT Picket Factsheet

GMB members within the Royal Pavilions and Museums Trust are in dispute with their employer over pay and conditions.

When they transferred out of Brighton & Hove City Council in October 2020, members of staff were told their terms and conditions would remain the same for the duration of the 25 year outsourcing contract.

A little more than 5 years later, they are being asked to sign new contracts which severs the link and means they will no longer enjoy the NJC (local government) contract terms.

We are asking any residents of Brighton & Hove, or any tourists or visitors to the Pavilion or any trust site, to have a look overleaf and think about supporting our striking members however you can.

The Pavilion is the symbol of Brighton and belongs to all of you.

This is your landmark, but this is their livelihood.

Here is how the general public can support our striking members and ensure the safekeeping of Brighton's number one visitor attraction:



1. Sign our petition to insist that management of the Trust stop forcing our members on to inferior contracts!

2. Sign our message book, and leave a message for whoever you want to - the Trust, the Council, local politicians or even a message of support for our striking members.



3. Consider making a donation to our Crowdfunder. These workers set up their own food bank, even before any contract changes. Any monies left over after the dispute is settled will be donated to that food bank.
