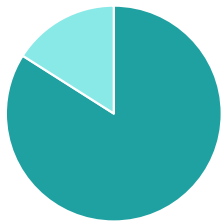
What do GMB members think about the culture within South East Coast Ambulance Service?

The main issues which were raised were:

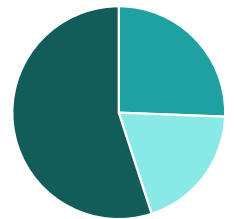
- Discrimination towards women staff members
